WINTER WONDERFEST – NOVEMBER 18 TO JANUARY 1 - Winter WonderFEST – made up of the Light Spectacular and Christmas Village. The 2-mile Light Spectacular is a drive-thru light show with more than 60 displays that brighten the night at Cape Henlopen State Park with beautiful colors. The Christmas Village at the Cape May-Lewes Ferry Terminal will have an ice skating rink, live music, indoor holiday workshops, a strolling Santa and carnival rides, including a giant Ferris wheel. Winter WonderFEST starts Friday, Nov. 18 with a 5K run and two-mile walk around Light Spectacular followed by an opening night party at Lewes' Crooked Hammock Brewery.
